Finding Celebrations and Areas of Growth in Your YouthTruth Data

Use this worksheet to do a Big Picture analysis of your reports focused on identifying celebrations and areas of growth in your Executive Summary.

Start by recording your observations using percent positives.

BIG PICTURE OBSERVATIONS

As you review your YouthTruth data, keep track of what you're learning. What do you notice? What do you wonder?

As you scan your data to get "The Big Picture" consider Are there trends across or within themes in your report? Do different groups of students have noticeably different responses from their peers? How does your data compare to other cohorts? If you have trend data, how does this year's data compare to the past?

I NOTICE (Write down key takeaways from your data)		I WONDER (Write down key questions your data raises)
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List three pieces of data that your school would like to celebrate and explain why.

Example: 94% of our students responded positively to the question "Does your teacher treat you with respect?"
We want to celebrate this because we grew 4% from last year, and respect is one of the most important values at our school.

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List three pieces of data that your school would like to improve, and explain why.

Example: 53% of our students responded positively to the question "Do students in your class treat the teacher with respect?" We want to improve this because we have declined 10% points over the last two years, and respect is a core value in our district strategic plan.

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
